Citation

- 1. This Determination may be cited as the 2003/2004 HIMI TAC D2.

Commencement

- 2. This Determination commences on gazettal.

Interpretation

- 3. A term used in this Determination that is defined for the purposes of the *Heard Island and McDonald Islands Fishery Management Plan 2002* has the same meaning in this determination as it has in that plan.

Determination of total allowable catch

- 4. The total allowable catches for the season in the Heard Island and McDonald Islands Fishery which commences on 1 December 2003 and which will end on 30 November 2004 are:

Target species:

Patagonian toothfish ( <i>Dissostichus eleginoides</i> )	2,873 tonnes
Mackerel icefish ( <i>Champscephalus gunnari</i> )	292 tonnes

Bycatch Species:

<i>Macrourus</i> spp	360 tonnes
Unicorn icefish ( <i>Channichthys rhinoceratus</i> )	150 tonnes
Skates and Rays ( <i>Bathyraja</i> spp.)	120 tonnes
Grey rockcod ( <i>Lepidonotothen squamifrons</i> )	80 tonnes
All other species	50 tonnes (for each species)
