TOTAL ALLOWABLE CATCH DETERMINATION – 2004/2005 SEASON

Citation

1. This Determination may be cited as the 2004/2005 HIMI TAC D3.

Commencement

2. This Determination commences on gazettal.

Interpretation

3. A term used in this Determination that is defined for the purposes of the *Heard Island and McDonald Islands Fishery Management Plan 2002* has the same meaning in this determination as it has in that plan.

Determination of total allowable catch

4. The total allowable catches for the season in the Heard Island and McDonald Islands Fishery which commences on 1 December 2004 and which will end on 30 November 2005 are:

Target species:

Patagonian toothfish (<i>Dissostichus eleginoides</i>)	2,787 tonnes
Mackerel icefish (<i>Champsocephalus gunnari</i>)	1,864 tonnes

Bycatch Species:

<i>Macrourus</i> spp	360 tonnes
Unicorn icefish (<i>Channichthys rhinoceratus</i>)	150 tonnes
Skates and Rays (<i>Bathyraja</i> spp.)	120 tonnes
Grey rockcod (<i>Lepidonotothen squamifrons</i>)	80 tonnes
All other species	50 tonnes (for each species)
