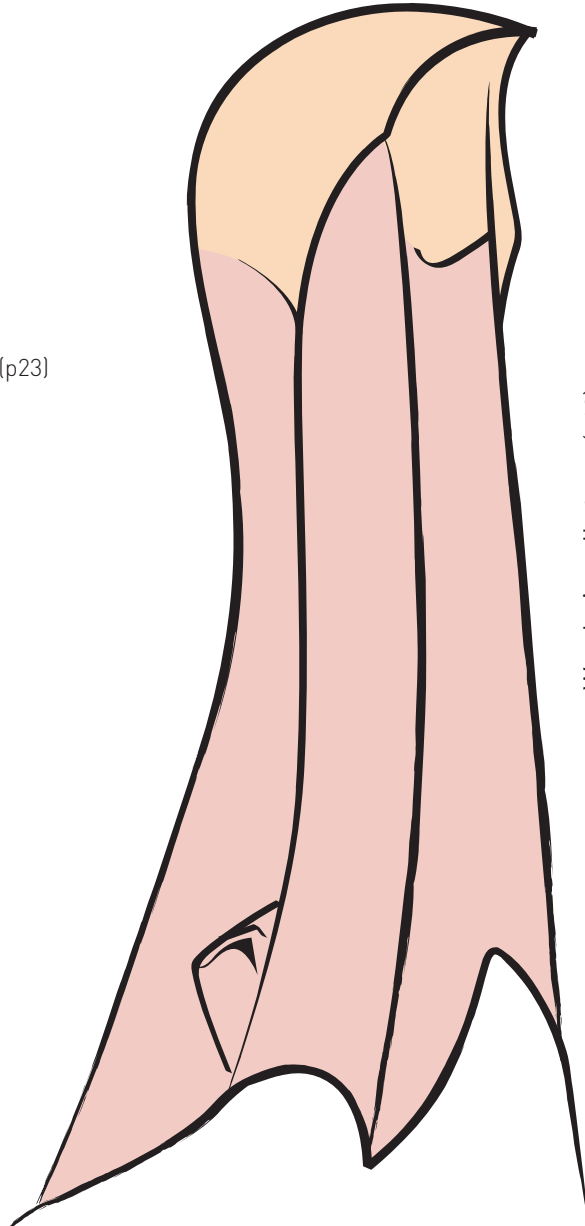
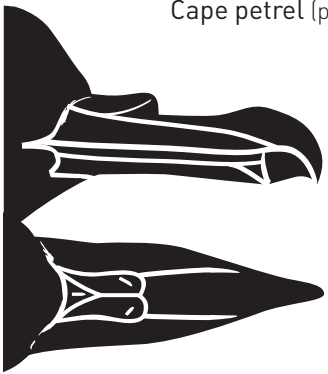
Westland petrel (p22)



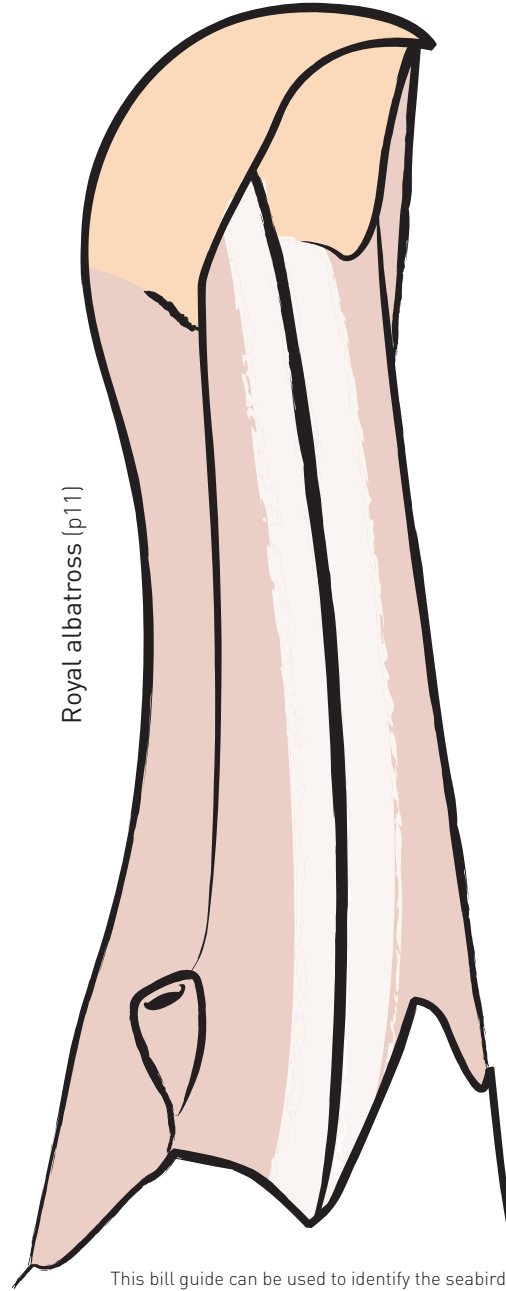
White-chinned petrel (p23)

Wandering albatross (p12)

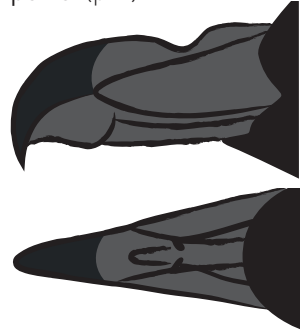

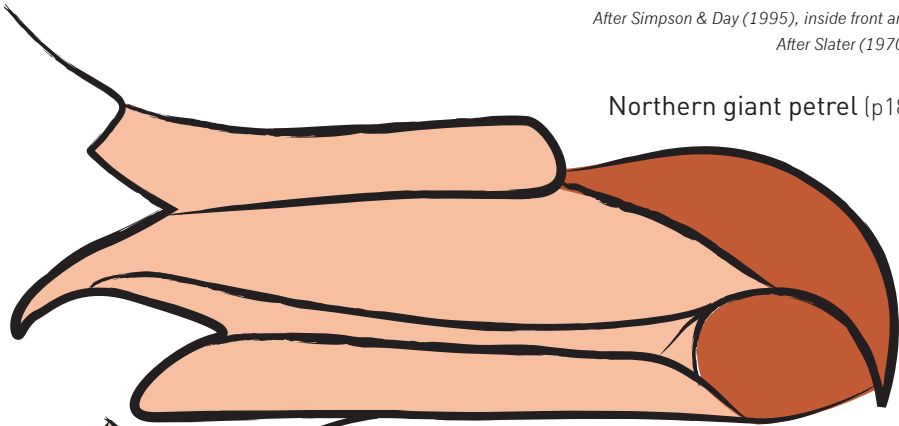

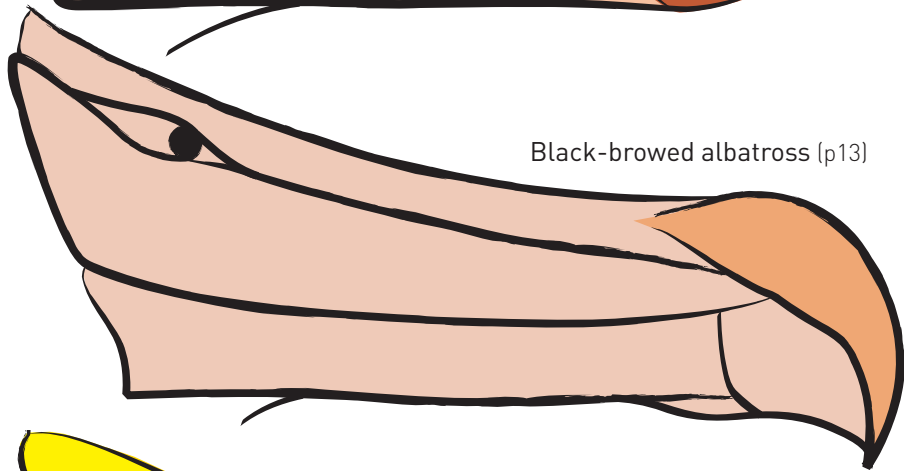

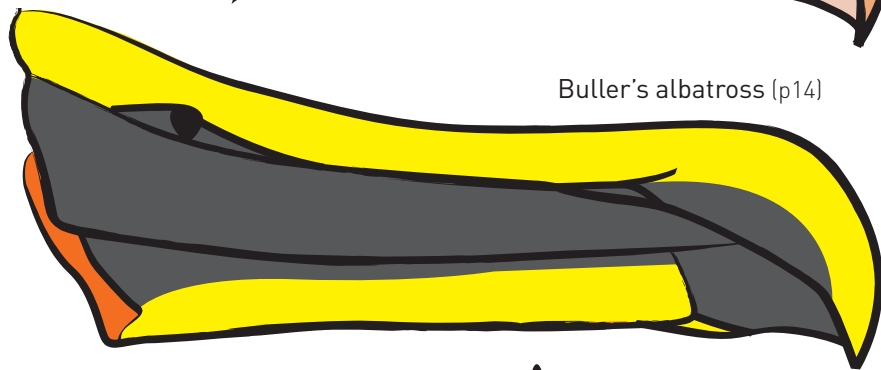

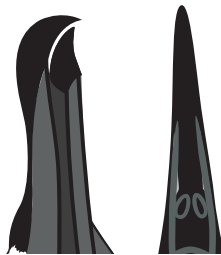
Black-browed albatross (p13)

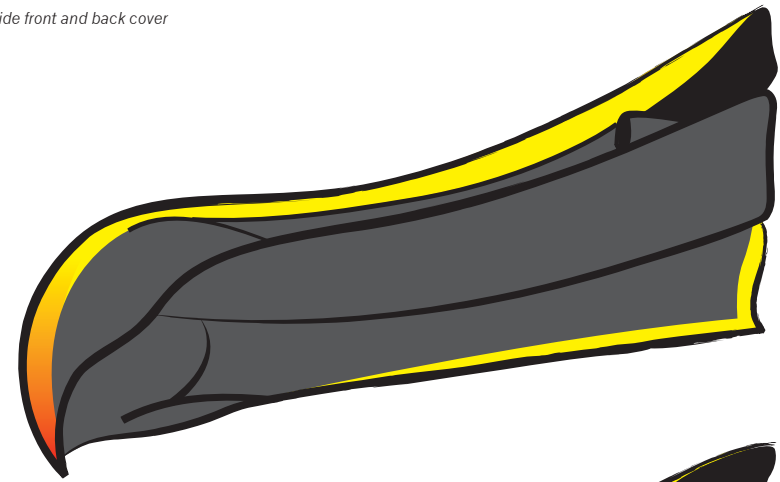

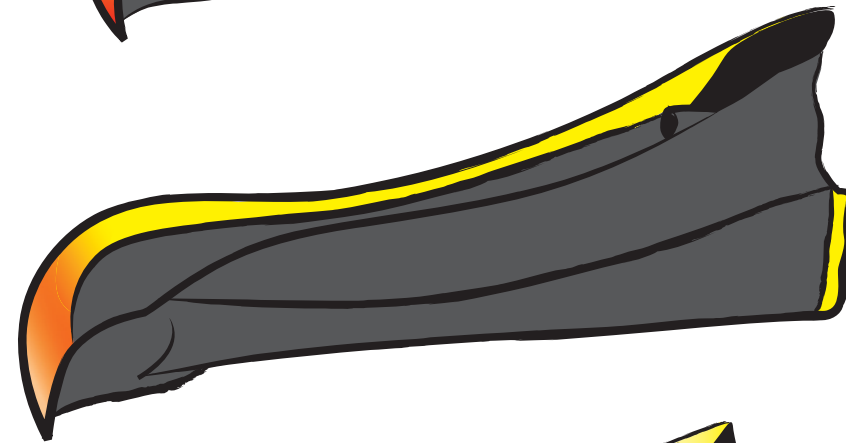

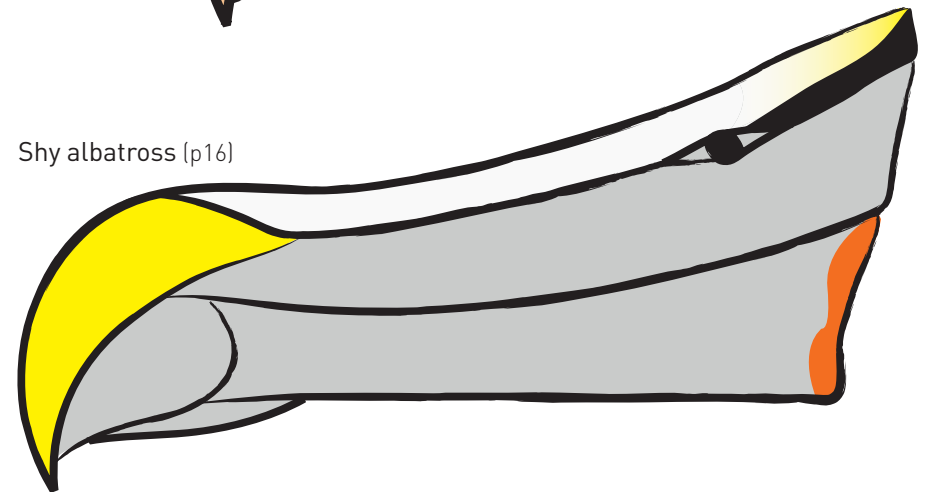
