



Information for new users of Electronic Logbooks (e-logs)

Electronic logbooks (e-logs) are an electronic alternative to paper logbooks used for daily catch reporting.

E-logs are submitted to AFMA using third party software. A list of available software providers can be found below and on the AFMA website.

Before you install e-logs

Fishing concession holders wishing to use e-logs on their boat should email AFMA at elogs@afma.gov.au.

Please include your:

- AFMA client ID (GoFish ID)
- Boat name
- Fishery and methods for which e-logs will be used.

Register GoFish and nominate agents

To use e-logs you must be registered with GoFish, AFMA's online portal.

If another person is going to submit e-logs on your behalf (such as a skipper) please make sure that they are registered on GoFish and nominated as an agent for your concession.

Setting up the e-log software

Your software provider will provide instructions on how to set up your e-logs software.

Please ensure you provide a valid email address to your software provider. The email address entered into the e-log software is the address to which AFMA will be sending all e-log correspondence including receipts for your e-log submissions.

Once the e-log software is setup

Once your e-logs software is set up your vendor will notify AFMA.

AFMA will use your paper logbooks to make sure that your e-logs is working correctly. Please continue to submit paper logbooks as well as your e-logs until AFMA instructs you to stop.
